

Upper Elementary East Supply List – 2018-2019

All students should bring on the **second day of school**:

Note: These items will be put in a collective pool to be used throughout the year. DO NOT label these with student names.

- 6 Spiral-bound, college-ruled, lined-paper notebooks (approx. 100 pages each)
- 3 Spiral-bound, 4 squares per inch, graph-paper notebooks (approx. 100 pages each)
- 1 Package of college-ruled lined paper (approx. 100 pages)
- 4 Packages of 100 lined, 3"x5" notecards
- 24 Ticonderoga yellow #2 pencils
- 12 Pencil-top eraser caps
- 10 Sponges
- 2 Rolls of translucent Scotch tape

In addition, **students who are new to the upper elementary classroom or have lost or damaged any of the following items during the previous school year will need:**

- 1 Insulated lunch container with handle and cool pack
- 1 Plastic or metal water bottle with strap
- 1 Sturdy backpack (this should be brought to school every day)
- 1 Spiral-bound sketch book (approx. 8.5"x11", at least 100 pages)
- 2 Translucent two-pocket folders, poly-material, no-hole fasteners (for homework and research)
- 1 Pair of soft-grip, straight-handled 7 in. scissors (we recommend Westcott)
- 1 12-inch translucent acrylic office ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 Index card file box for 3" x 5" index cards

Students will be labeling these items with their names to be kept in the classroom and used by the students. These items should also be brought to school on the second day of school.

All students will need the following items at home in order to successfully complete homework assignments:

- Stapler w/staples
- Notebook filler paper, college-ruled, white
- 4-Square per inch graph paper
- A simple drawing compass or circle template
- A small plastic protractor
- A ruler (must have centimeters and inches)
- Pencils (regular and red to use for revisions/editing)
- Dictionary
- Thesaurus
- Index cards (3" x 5", lined, white) for research reports
