STUDENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

PARENT'S RESPONSIBILITIES

1. To provide access to the necessary resources and materials for history, science, and other class projects such as transportation to the local library.
2. To have child attend school regularly and punctually.
3. To attend scheduled parent/ teacher conferences, the August All-Parent Meeting, and to participate in establishing the educational plan (goal setting).
4. To support the participation in outdoor education activities and attend scheduled trip meetings.
5. To encourage their student to finish their work in a timely fashion and to make-up unfinished work before school, during recess, or after school.
6. To meet with the teacher if student's behavior requires a conference.
7. To provide a time and place at home conducive to completing homework on a daily basis.
8. To allow their student to experience feedback in learning organizational, decision making, time-management, and social skills.
9. To read and accept the policies and procedures of the KMS Parent Handbook and the KMS Education Position Papers.
10. To understand and accept the KMS grievance procedures and student behavioral policy.
