

Upper Elementary Supply List – 2022 -2023

All students should bring on the **second day of school**:

Note: These items will be put in a collective pool for use throughout the year. Please DO NOT label these with student names.

- 4 spiral-bound, college-ruled, lined-paper notebooks (approx. 100 pages each)
- 4 spiral-bound, 4 squares per inch, graph-paper notebooks (approx. 100 pages each)
- 2 composition, college-ruled notebooks (approx. 100 pages each)
- 2 packages of college-ruled lined paper (approx. 100 pages each)
- 2 packages of graphing paper (approx. 100 pages each)
- 1 3-ring binder with pockets (1")
- 2 spiral-bound sketchbooks
- 3 packages of 100 lined, white 3"x5" notecards
- 12 Ticonderoga yellow #2 pencils
- 2 Two-pocket folders, poly-material, no hole fasteners
- 2 rolls of translucent Scotch tape
- 1 12-inch translucent acrylic office ruler with inches and centimeters
- 1 container Lysol, Clorox, or alcohol wipes
- 1 pair of dishwashing gloves

In addition, students who are new to the upper elementary classroom or have lost or damaged any of the following items during the previous school year will need:

- 1 insulated lunch container with a handle and cool pack
- 1 plastic or metal water bottle with a strap (water bottles in a carrier must be brought by students when on field trips)
- 1 sturdy backpack (this should be brought to school every day)
- 1 pair of soft-grip, straight-handled 7 in. scissors (we recommend Westcott)
- 1 index card file box for 3" x 5" index cards

Students will be labeling these items with their names to be kept in the classroom and used by the students. These items should also be brought to school on the second day.

All students will need the following items at home in order to successfully complete homework assignments:

- Stapler w/staples
- Notebook filler paper, college-ruled, white
- 4-square per inch graph paper
- A simple drawing compass or circle template
- A small plastic protractor
- A ruler (must have centimeters and inches)
- Pencils (regular and red to use for revisions/editing)
- Dictionary
- Thesaurus
- Index cards (3" x 5", lined, white) for research reports

An \$80 literature book fee for each student will be collected in August.
